المقدمة

يركز المجلد 1 على مجالين للبحث على وجه الخصوص، شمال دار فور وقوات الدعم السريع.

جغرافياً، شمال دارفور هو محور التركيز. أجريت العديد من المقابلات مع الدارفوريين أو العاملين في القضايا والمسائل المطروحة في دارفور. هل دارفور، مع العدد الكبير من سكانها النازحين داخلياً، جاهزة للانتخابات من منظور لوجستي؟ هل لدى دارفور الوقت لتشكيل أحزاب سياسية؟ إذا لم يكن الأمر كذلك، فهل يمكن للنخبة النيلية ترك الإقليم في الوراثة مرة أخرى؟

داخل الحكومة، يتم التركيز على قوات الدعم السريع وقائدها الفريق حميدتي. تتساءل سلسلة من المقالات عن كيفية ملاءمة قوات الدعم السريع للمجتمع السوداني الانتقالي، وكيف تم النظر لها في وسائل الإعلام، وماذا يمكن أن تأخذ عملية الحقيقة والمصالحة في الاعتبار وهي تواصل سيرها. نحن نسميها عملية "الحقيقة والمصالحة"، لكن الكثيرين سيشعرون أنها إما حقيقة أو مصالحة. تم استخدام قوات الدعم السريع كدراسة حالة لكشف إمكانية هذا التقسيم، وتم تقديم أحد الحلول الممكنة من منظور علم الاجتماع.

يجمع مقال مصور الموضوعين، قوات الدعم السريع ودارفور، معاً. حظي المؤلف بامتياز قضاء بعض الوقت في شمال دارفور مع كل من قوات الدعم السريع والعديد من المضيفين المحليين، الذين كان كرمهم الفياض لافتاً ووافراً ونعمة حسنة.
